LAW AND ORDER

THE UNCHANGEABLE TEN COMMANDMENTS

The Ten Commandments given to Moses were the basis for a constitution for the nation of Israel. They were not only given to Israel but they are the foundation for all civilizations who believe in the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. They are the law of God.

Preamble: **Exodus 20:1-2**

Commandment 1: Do not worship idols – **verse 3**

Commandment 2: Do not make any graven images from the spirit world – **verses 4-6**

Commandment 3: Do not profane the name of the Lord – **verse 7**

Commandment 4: Keep the Sabbath holy – **verses 8-11**

Commandment 5: Honor your parents – **verse 12**

Commandment 6: Do not murder – **verse 13**

Commandment 7: Do not commit adultery – **verse 14**

Commandment 8: Do not steal – **verse 15**

Commandment 9: Do not lie – **verse 16**

Commandment 10: Do not covet – **verse 17**

These laws were given to Moses 3,535 years ago and they have withstood the test of time. They will continue to stand until God dissolves this creation. **Matthew 5:17-19; Revelation 21:1**
